

RESOLUTION NO. R-06 - 2019

A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH ESTABLISHING FIREWORKS RESTRICTIONS FOR 2019

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, in accordance with Utah Code §53-7-225, Class C common state approved explosives (fireworks) may only be discharged beginning on July 2 and ending on July 5, and beginning on July 22 and ending on July 25; and


WHEREAS, if existing or historical hazardous environmental conditions exist within the boundaries of Eagle Mountain City, Utah Code §15A-5-202.5 allows the City Council to prohibit the ignition and use of fireworks in the following areas: (1) mountainous, brush-covered, forest-covered, or dry grass-covered areas; (2) within 200 feet of waterways, trails, canyons, washes, ravines, or similar areas; (3) wildland urban interface area, which means the line, area, or zone where structures or other human development meet or intermingle with undeveloped wildland or land being used for an agricultural purpose; or (4) a limited area outside the hazardous areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Eagle Mountain City, Utah, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby determines that historical hazardous environmental conditions have existed in the areas designated on the *Eagle Mountain City 2019 Firework Closed Area Map* before July 1 of at least two of the preceding five years, which map is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.
2. All fireworks will be prohibited during calendar year 2019 in the areas designated as "Closed" on the *Eagle Mountain City 2019 Firework Closed Area Map*.
3. In accordance with Utah Code §15A-5-202.5, on or before May 1, 2019, the *Eagle Mountain City 2019 Firework Closed Area Map* shall be provided to Utah County.
4. In addition to any other fines, penalties, or liability allowed under Utah law, in accordance with Utah Code §53-7-225, a person is guilty of an infraction, punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000, if the person discharges a Class C common state approved explosive: (a) outside the legal discharge dates and times described in Utah Code §53-7-225(3); or (b) in an area designated as "Closed" on the *Eagle Mountain City 2019 Firework Closed Area Map*.



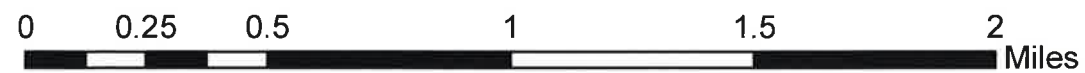
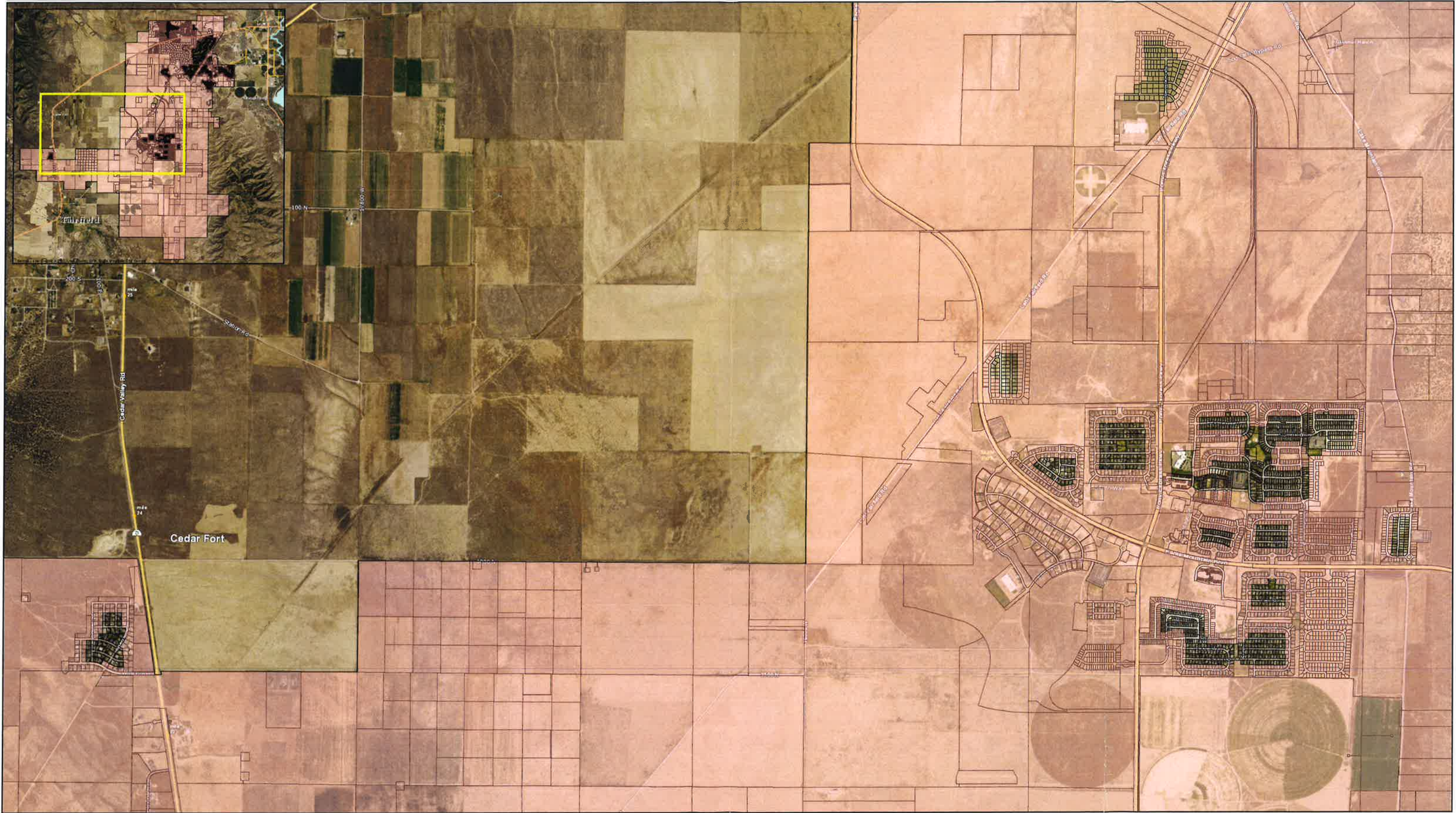

Eagle Mountain City Firework Restrictions Map: City Center

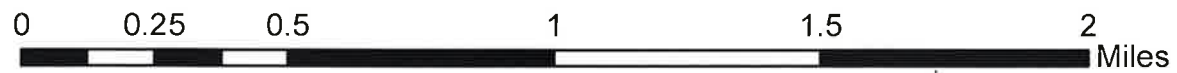
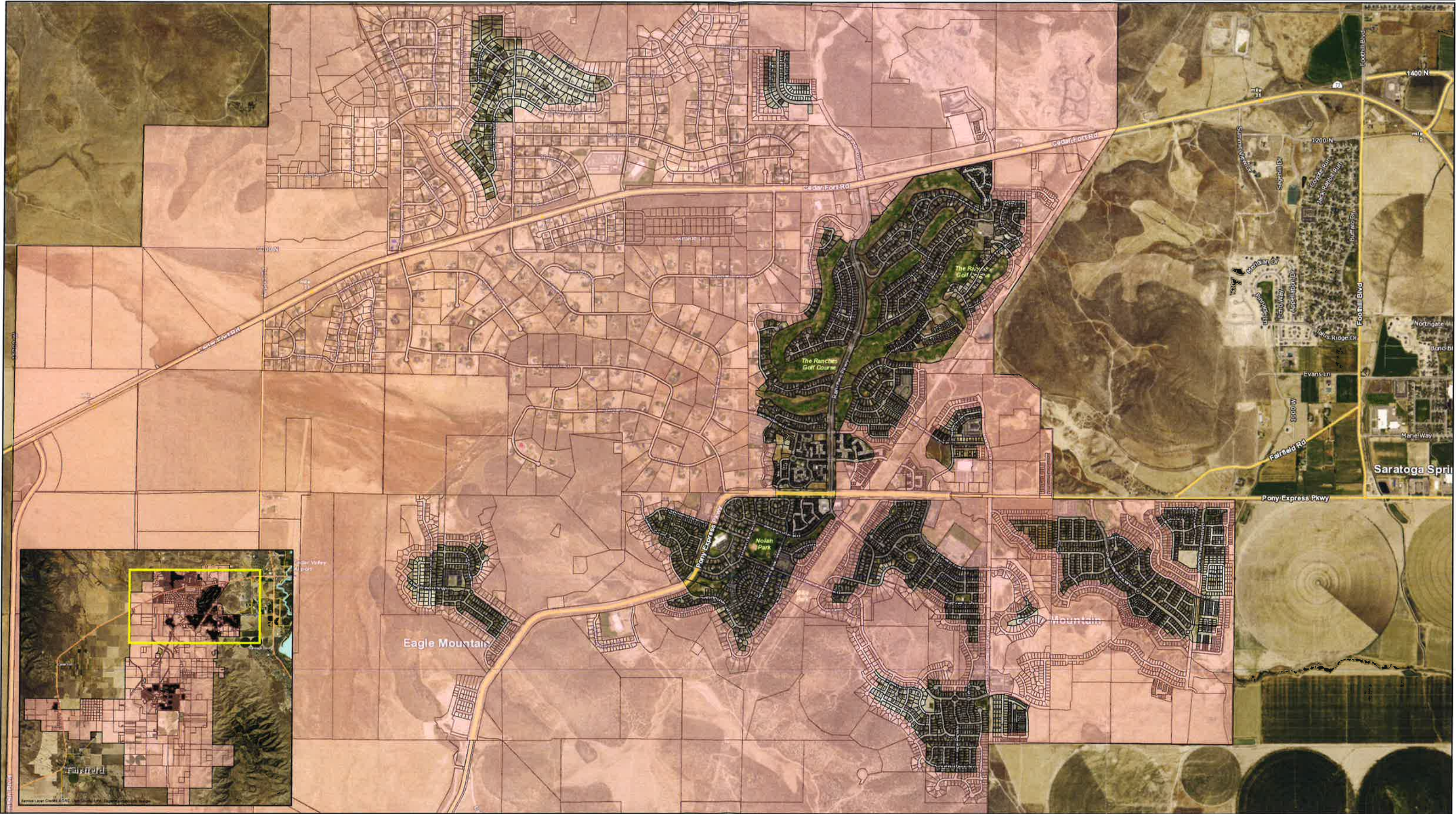


 Restricted Firework Areas
