FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED MASTER DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE OVERLAND DEVELOPMENT AND PONY EXPRESS PARCEL

This First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Master Development Agreement for the Overland Development and Pony Express Parcel ("First Amendment") is entered into this 20H day of August, 2019 ("Effective Date"), by and between Eagle Mountain City ("City"), a political subdivision of the State of Utah, the State of Utah, School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration, and Ivory Homes, Ltd, ("Ivory") a Utah limited partnership, sometimes referred to jointly herein as "Parties."

RECITALS:

WHEREAS The Parties previously entered into that certain Amended and Restated Master Development Agreement for the Overland Development and Pony Express Parcel dated December 5, 2017 ("Agreement") with respect to real property located in Eagle Mountain City, State of Utah ("Property");

WHEREAS the Parties have cooperated in the preparation of this First Amendment and desire to enter into this First Amendment to modify and add certain terms to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, covenants, representations and warranties hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Definitions</u>. All capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the same meanings assigned such terms in the Agreement.
- 2. <u>Timing for Construction of Amenities.</u> Section 11.3.1 of the Agreement shall be amended and restates as follows:

A Club Ivory and an approximately 4-acre park in Village 1 will begin construction by December 15, 2019 and will be completed prior to the earlier of the recording of a plat containing the 350th Building Permit or June 30th, 2020;

3. <u>Trees.</u> A Section 12.9 shall be added to the Agreement and shall state as follows:

Ivory shall work with Eagle Mountain City Parks Department to pay for and install one hundred (100) trees in the Pony Express median from Lake Mountain Road to Bobby Wren Blvd. The trees shall be installed by November 30, 2019.

4. <u>Subordination of Conflicting Terms</u>. In the event of a conflict in the terms and conditions of this First Amendment with the terms and conditions of the Agreement, the terms and conditions of this First Amendment shall be binding and govern the conduct of the parties.

- 5. <u>No Other Changes</u>. All provisions in the Agreement as it may have been previously amended not specifically amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- 6. <u>Counterparts</u>. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered, shall be deemed an original, but with all such counterparts being taken together to constitute a single original.
