

RESOLUTION NO. R-22-2018

**A RESOLUTION RENAMING LAKE VIEW ESTATES PARK
TO RODNEY CHASE ALLRED MEMORIAL PARK**

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, proposes renaming Lake View Estates Park to Rodney Chase Allred Memorial Park in memory of three generations of Rodney Chase Allreds; and

WHEREAS, Rodney Chase Allred, a teacher and farmer, bought the land many years ago and grew wheat there to provide income for his family; and

WHEREAS, in 1969 the property was inherited by his five surviving children, including Rodney Chase Allred, Jr.; and


WHEREAS, in 2004, the land was bequeathed to Rodney Chase Allred, Jr.'s seven children; including Rodney Chase Allred III; and
