Solicitors

Please be aware that door-to-door solicitors are required to obtain a solicitation license from Eagle Mountain City (with the exception of religious/charitable groups). This process includes a background check. Solicitors who have a license are required to display it in a lanyard necklace. The license has the City's name on it. If you are contacted by solicitors without the license, you may report them to Code Enforcement Officer Mike Malay at (385) 329-6266 or mmalay@emcity.org. Please include the company name and any additional information so he may make contact and advise of our policy. After hours you may call the sheriff's office dispatch at (801) 794-3970.

Finance Award

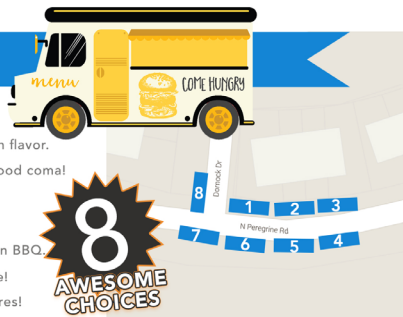
