AS WE'VE HEADED BACK TO SCHOOL AND RETURNED TO OUR COMMUTING ROUTINES, A REVIEW OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND A PROGRESS REPORT MAY BE IN ORDER SO THAT WE ALL KNOW WHAT TO EXPECT.

Road construction season will continue through fall. The good news is that once completed, traffic will flow much better and make commute time shorter and smoother.

Pony Express Medians Project

- o This project will add turn pockets along Pony Express between Sandpiper Rd and Bobby Wren Blvd at existing and future intersection locations to accommodate future widening.
- o Crews have removed the existing median near Hidden Valley Pkwy (Hidden Hollow Elementary entrance) and will have the intersection finished during the last week of August.
- o Pony Express Pkwy will be widened to five lanes through Hidden Valley Parkway as part of this current project.
- o Final completion for this project is targeted for end of October.

Pony Express Widening to Redwood

- o This project will widen Pony Express Parkway from Porter's Crossing to Redwood Road.
- o The final cross section will be 5 lanes, plus two bike lanes. Center median islands are not included in this project
 - o This project will include a traffic signal at

SilverLake Parkway. Installation of the traffic light is expected to begin soon.

- o Periodic lane restrictions will occur between Porter's Crossing and SilverLake Parkway as utilities are installed prior to the road work.
- o Sections of the existing asphalt will be milled and replaced with a thicker asphalt section.
- o Project completion is expected to be end of September.

Black Ridge Elementary Trails

- o The City is currently soliciting bids for this project.
- o Trails and sidewalk will be added to Sunset Drive and Hummer Drive.
- o Anticipated completion for this project is end of October

Smith Ranch Traffic Light

- o Eagle Mountain has recently awarded the design contract for this traffic light.
- o Design is anticipated to be complete near the end of November and installation to be Spring 2019.

Pony Express Parkway Widening- Hidden Hollow to Oquirrh Mountain Ranch

- o Eagle Mountain City will continue the widening of Pony Express Parkway from the existing three lanes to five lanes from Hidden Valley Parkway to Oquirrh Mountain Blvd.
- o A new water line will also be added between Lake Mountain Road and Cedar Drive.
- o This project will include a traffic signal at Hidden Valley Parkway and Pony Express.
- o This project is expected to begin early 2019 and be completed by Fall 2019.

Aviator Avenue Completion

- o Eagle Mountain City will complete Aviator Avenue between Cedar Valley High School and Eagle Mountain Blvd. This construction work is expected to occur spring of 2019
- o A traffic signal will also be installed at the intersection of Aviator Avenue and Pony Express Parkway.

Mid Valley Road Traffic Light

- o A traffic light will be added to Pony Express Parkway at Mid Valley road prior to the opening of Cedar Valley High School and projected traffic increases in this area.
- This project is expected to occur Spring 2019.

Water Violations

If you have a violation pertaining to water, the following notice will be placed on your front door or in your mailbox. We ask that you resolve the issue as soon as possible.



The following violation(s) need your attention:

Water Department may not be able to read your meter

Weeds and Other Refuse.

Weeds shall not be permitted to reach a height of more than 6 inches at any time, weeds, refuse and unsightly objects must be removed (8.07.020).

Access to Premise

...it shall be unlawful to obstruct in any way the ability of authorized personnel to gain access to the premises' water meter. It shall also be unlawful to place any material in the water meter barrel without the written approval of the director of the water division (13.20.080).

Run Off

...Property owners are responsible to manage storm water runoff and sediment whether in conduit systems or on the surface that traverse or originate on their property, unless this responsibility is relinquished through the terms and conditions of an easement.

NEIGHBORHOOD NOTICE

Water Meters and Service Lines

... No meters shall be set in sidewalks or driveways. Meter boxes shall be in good repair and relatively free from obstruction to ensure ease in maintenance and reading (not full of dirt past the base of the meter, having trash present and being badly bent to create a hazard). Damaged boxes shall be replaced (15.35.050).

Sprinkler Irrigation Hours Restricted

It shall be unlawful for the owner or person in control of a sprinkler irrigation system connected to the Eagle Mountain City water system to operate an irrigation system during the day between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of each day (13.30.010).

Clean Gutter

Once curb and gutter and surface course is in place it shall be kept as clean as possible. When equipment is required to cross over sidewalk, bridging will be provided to protect concrete. Dirt and gravel will not be placed in gutter or on street. Gutter will flow freely at all times (15.65.060).

Water Waste

It shall be unlawful for any water user to waste water, or allow it to be asted, by imperfect stops, taps, valves, leaky joints or pipes, or allow tanks or water troughs to leak or overflow or to wastefully run water from hydrants, faucets, or stops or through basins, water closets, urinals, sinks, or apparatus or to use water in violation of the rules, regulations, or ordinances for controlling the city water system (13.20.160)
